- I. R/V with Vinegrove 1-1, just south of Egmond, 1045, 23,000'. Bomber formations were good within the boxes. Visual and identification made at R/V. Escorted them around and through the tgt. and out to Brussels, 1330, 15,000'. Bombers bombed the tgt. at 1205, 28,000', through 10/10 overcast. No E/A were engaged and no bombers were seen to go down.
  - OBSERVATIONS:
    1. V-2 seen heading west 1055, zuider Zee.
  - 2. Two to four work jet contrails seen at 1100, 35 to 40,000', Zuider Zee.
  - 3. 1 V-2 contrail seen at 1208, in vic of Homburg
  - FLAK:
  - 1. Flak was heavy, meager and accurate over the tgt.
